We'll send the recording link to your registered email address on Sunday 16 August. If you can't see it, don't forget to check your spam or junk folder—sometimes even the best stories end up there first!

HOW LONG IS THE NATIONAL READ ALONG?

The recording runs for approximately 15 minutes, including a warm welcome, the story, and a few special surprises.

WILL THE READ ALONG BE AVAILABLE AFTERWARDS?

Unfortunately not. Due to copyright restrictions, the National Read Along recording will only be available at 11.00am on Monday 17 August. Be sure to gather your readers and press PLAY at 11.00am so you don't miss this special nationwide reading moment.

CAN FAMILIES JOIN FROM HOME?

Absolutely! The National Read Along is for everyone—schools, libraries, early learning services, whānau and communities right across Aotearoa.

CAN ANYONE STILL REGISTER?
